

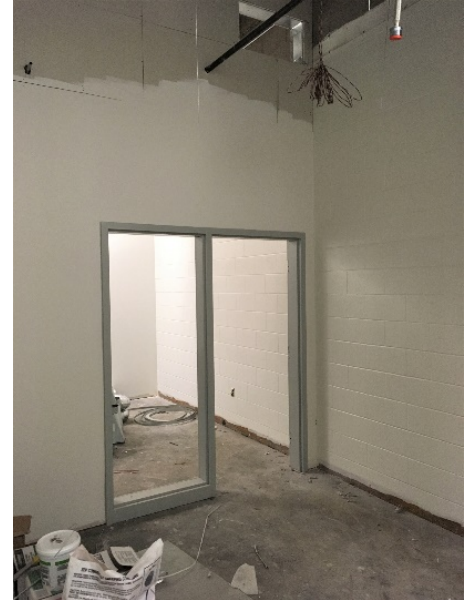
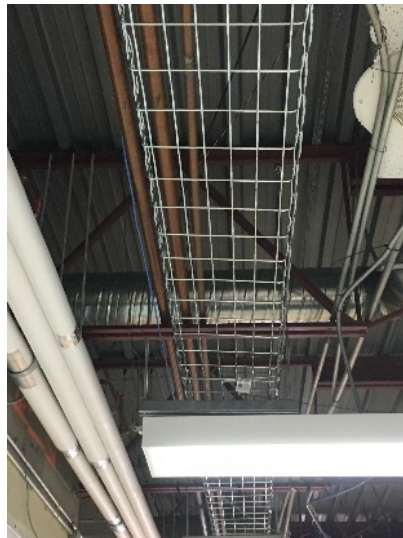
Behind the Scenes and Above the Ceilings

An upwards glance while standing in our school corridors, for example, reveals the many water pipes that have already been installed. These will eventually bring water to every one of our classrooms, including the new modular.

What a huge improvement that will be! (At present, only three of our classrooms have a water supply.) In addition, those water pipes will supply our school's new sprinkler system, thus contributing to a safer learning and working environment for everyone in the building.

Further, the pipes will circulate the hot water in our school's new radiant heating system, a vast improvement over the antiquated and struggling hot air system that is presently in place.

Also above the ceilings is the cable tray that will carry new state-of-the-art information technology cable throughout the building.



Behind the scenes (i.e. behind the sealed-off area in the northeast sector of the building), progress continues to be made on the classroom and office spaces that will be located there. Following the removal of old walls and flooring materials, work crews have built new walls and doorways, installed wiring and other conduits, mounted drywall, and have now reached the painting stage. T-bar ceilings and new flooring will soon follow. We anticipate that we will be able to move into these renovated spaces by the end of February.
