Approval of gym mats carried over from 2015/2016 school year

MOTION: Manda Wilde moved to reimburse \$494.21 out of the School Enhancement fund for the purchase of gym mats. Dena Freed seconded. Motion carried

• Discussion of approving amounts for yearly recurring expenditure to ease repayment (forgotten lunches, teacher incentives):

MOTION: Brandy Cox moves to approve up to \$500 (\$50 per class) for the purchase of recess equipment. These amounts will come from the Classroom Support fund. Seconded by Manda Wilde. Motion carried.

MOTION: Manda Wilde moves to approve up to \$5 per student for each class (with an additional \$125 in total to the French Teacher for the French classes) for student incentives. These amounts will come from the Classroom Support fund. Seconded by Dena Freed. Motion carried.

MOTION: Manda Wilde moves to approve up to \$250 to be paid from the School Support fund to supply back-up lunches. Seconded by Brandy Cox. Motion carried.

Discussion for approval of cost to support parent lecture by Dianne Gossen \$500:

MOTION: Brandy Cox moves to reimburse the school \$500 from the Community Building/Parent Support fund for the Dianne Gossen lecture. Seconded by Dena Freed. Motion carried.

• Request from the administration for Sphere-o Robots. \$150 each, requesting \$300 to cover the cost of 2.

MOTION: Dena Freed moved to approve up to \$300 to acquire two sphere-o robots at a cost of \$150 each. This amount will come from the school support fund. Seconded by Manda Wilde. Motion carried.

 Request from the administration for Circuit Scribe conductive ink kits. Requesting a classroom set for \$1200

MOTION: Manda Wilde moved approve up to \$1200 to acquire a classroom set of Circuit Scribe Conductive Ink Kits. This amount will come from the school support fund. Seconded by Brandy Cox. Motion carried.

• Request from the administration that council fund the cost of having the nighthawks logo be printed on the new crashmats for the wall underneath the basketball hoop.

MOTION: Brandy Cox moved that subject to the administration investigating the durability of logo, that we approve up to \$1000 for the addition of the Nighthawks logo to the basketball end-zone crash mats. This amount will come from the School Enhancement fund. Seconded by Dena Freed. Motion carried.

• Request from administration for \$5,000 to support Artist in Residence project
