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New Horizons is Nut Aware

As we have a diverse population and nut allergies are common. New Horizons School is nut aware and we ask that parents and students adhere to our guidelines to promote the safety of everyone coming in to our school. Put simply, we do not provide any foods that contain nuts and nut products and require families to refrain from sending foods with nut products to school. In addition to being Nut Aware we also discourage students from sharing food from lunches and snacks as there are many other foods to which students are allergic.

Early/Late Pick-up and Drop off

The following are just a reminder about picking up and dropping off:

- All students arriving late or leaving early must be signed in and out at the office by a parent or guardian.
- Students arriving late will be given a late slip so that the classroom teacher will know they have been checked in at the office.
- If students will be late, absent or picked up early, please email your child's teacher and Lisa Richardson in the office to let us know at your earliest convenience.
- If arrangements have been made for students to be pickedup rather than riding the bus, please let the office know before 2:00 p.m. when possible. This allows us time to get the message to the student and his/her teacher.
- As our school lets out at 3:14 p.m., please refrain from coming into the school earlier than 3:00 p.m. to avoid disruptions to student learning.

Volunteering at NHS

There are many options for parents wanting to get involved to help out at New Horizons! Such volunteer opportunities include:

- Classroom prep help-cutting, sorting and collating learning materials; putting up bulletin boards; organizing learning centres
- Field trip chaperones-this may include out of school or inschool field trips
