## 4. Education Plan and Annual Education Results Report (AERR)

#### **Information:**

At its November 21 meeting, the NHS Board of Directors approved our three year Education Plan and the AERR for 2017-2019.

The AERR and the Education Plan focus on our three Charter Goals, and five Alberta Education Goals for school jurisdictions.

Using our own measure for our goals, and the Accountability Surveys (completed by parents in grades 4-9) and Provincial Achievement Test results for the Alberta Education Goals, the AERR looks at how well we performed in relation to the goals during the 2017-2018 school year.

Using the same goals, the Education Plan identifies strategies and areas to focus on for the next three years. The areas of focus are identified through the annual stakeholder forum, survey data, and other data.

The Education Plan helps to direct human resources and financial resources to specific areas of growth that are identified in the plan.

The Combined AERR and Education Plan will be posted on our website by November 30.
